Employment Information ...

- ♥ **Moreau Lake State Park:** Various jobs available (listed below); all pay \$8.35/hour; applicant must be at least 16 years old; the length of employment is from Memorial Day to Labor Day or from the end of the school year to Labor Day. Weekends are required. Please complete an application at the park office (605 Old Saratoga Road, Gansevoort, 12804; 793-0511).
Deadline: March 1, 2010
 - **Toll Booth Attendant:** Work in the toll booth at the entrance of the park
 - **Boat Rental Attendant:** Work at the rental station at the beach renting rowboats, umbrellas, and lounge chairs. Shift hours from 10 a.m. - 6:30 p.m.
 - **Maintenance:** Work full time as part of the maintenance crew doing building and grounds maintenance. Most of the work is outside; shift hours vary depending on the positions available.
 - **Office Person:** Work full time in the office running the computerized camping system, dispensing information to the public and answering phones. Must be good with computers and dealing with the public.
